7.00	Exercise 1: Critique of examples of vision statements from other towns and villages. Exercise carried out in groups, using checklist provided, followed by feedback and recording of learning points	<i>Groups</i>
7.45	What issue's does East Leake's neighbourhood plan need to address? Review of planning issues raised in two previous workshops, followed by discussion and decision on format to adopt for East Leake's vision.	<i>Introduced by Andy Beard</i>
8.00	Exercise 2: Producing the vision for East Leake Groups will start the process of writing the vision for East Leake, and prepare a series of headings and points that they consider are priorities to be included in the statement. Maps, paper and pens provided.	<i>Groups as before</i>
